

Our objective: enabling FAIR and Open Access

We want to increase <u>visibility</u> of our research outputs and <u>facilitate finding relevant research(ers)</u> for internal and external audiences.

We want to ensure that the records in our repositories etc. are <u>FAIR and findable</u> via international aggregation services.

We want to <u>comply with requirements</u> to have open metadata records in our repositories.





Solution: The EUTOPIA Open Research Portal

- As of now: 667,861 records
- Including **439,819** in Open Access
- Launched during International Open Access Week 2022

EUTOPIA is an ambitious alliance of 10 like-minded universities ready to reinvent themselves: the Babeş-Bolyai University in Cluj-Napoca (Romania), the Vrije Universiteit Brussels (Belgium), the Ca'Foscari University of Europe (Italy), CY Cergy Paris Université (France), the Technische Universität Dresden (Germany), the University of Gothenburg (Sweden), the University of Ljubljana (Slovenia), the NOVA University Lisbon (Portugal), the University of Pompeu Fabra (Spain) and the University of Warwick (United Kingdom). Together, these 10 pioneers join forces to build the university of the future.




The technical side

Teaming up with OpenAIRE allowed us to create a CONNECT Community Gateway which has multiple benefits for the alliance.

- Minimal maintenance needed
- Long-term availability of the platform via OpenAIRE
- Additional services can be developed via
 API
- Integrated search for Zenodo community, project results etc.

At the moment, 8 out of 10 EUTOPIA repositories are harvested by OpenAIRE.
