



SDG3 Session: Health and Well-Being

- In the health-related sectors, there are also commercial actors (e.g. pharma), who hesitate to use the EOSC community resources
 - Part of it has to do with open source: many licenses, many versions We could work on simplified licensing models ...
- Many of the use cases are making heavy use of the 07 project resources, which are expiring “soon” (e.g., mid-2023).
 - “There are many paths to sustainability” – of course the 07 projects are putting measures into place, but the use cases nearly always have also important relationships with other resources, e.g. national funding, etc.
- Integrating a service (e.g., OpenEBench) into the EOSC marketplace is an important way to ensure that the service can be seen and exploited by many different users in multiple domains – important for life sciences
